Sacrament of Penance Helpful Guide

Before entering the confessional, take the time to make a good EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE (see below) to determine all sins which need to be reconciled with God and the Church.

AFTER the SIGN of the CROSS:

"Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been -(state the length of time)- since my last confession. These are my sins..."

Now, mention the sins you are to confess. Mortal sins must be confessed in sacramental Confession to be forgiven. Venial sins may be confessed in general terms.

"I am sorry for these and all of my sins."

The priest may say a few words, then assigns your penance. Then you pray the Act of Contrition:

ACT of CONTRITION

"O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest my sins because of your just punishments, but most of all because they offend You, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Your grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to amend my life. Amen."

ABSOLUTION

The priest prays the words of absolution. Following individual Confession, complete the penance required.
