Dear St. Mary,

After almost a year and a half of wrestling and discerning with the Lord, I have come to the recognition that God is calling me to leave my position as Director of Youth Ministry. I am not leaving because of issues or anything of that sort. Actually, ministry is great and I really love our staff and priests, especially

Fr. Mosimann. So, why am I leaving? Well, God has made it clear to me that I have done as much as I can here at St. Mary and it is time to hand this program over to someone who will take it to the next level. It is an incredibly humbling thing to hear God say, "You have done all you can." I didn't necessarily accept this at first, but as I entered into discernment I recognized this was the right thing. I am glad to see that, through the Lord's grace, I have done everything in my power to make this Youth Ministry program a great one. I am even more excited to know that God has someone else in mind to make it even greater.

Even though I had not gone to a single job interview, I approached Fr. Mosimann in January and told him about my discernment. Father was sad to hear the news, but was amazingly supportive. "I'll have you as long as I can" was his response. I am very grateful for Fr. Mosimann's willingness to work with me and my family's needs for the last several months as I searched for a new job. Many are curious as to where I am going next. I have accepted a job as a government contractor with a company in Dahlgren, VA. The plan is to start there in early June.

The last 10 years have been an incredible journey for me and for our Youth Ministry program. We have gone from a tiny 10-person youth group to a massive program with multiple youth groupings, serving hundreds of students year round. It has been an amazing decade! I have really loved my time here. I have had the privilege and honor to be part of some of your families' most memorable and difficult moments.

I have laughed and cried with you. There are just no words to convey how grateful I am for my time here. My family and I are staying in the area, so we will continue to attend St. Mary.

In the last several months, I've been working behind the scenes reaching out to folks whom I think may meet the needs of our youth ministry program. We will post the job description with application instructions on the Diocesan site as well as other Youth Ministry job boards. We hope to have someone in place by the end of June/beginning of July. Our Youth Program is pretty special and extensive, so we are

looking for a very specific person to direct it. We are blessed to have Tatiana Beltran, the Assistant Director of Youth Ministry to help facilitate this transition.

Thanks again, St. Mary for an amazing 10 years! Looking forward to ten more as a member of this great parish.



On Tuesday, May 14, we will meet in the John Paul II House and will discuss John O'Neill's The Fisherman's Tomb, The True Story of the Vatican's Secret Search. In 1939, a team of workers beneath the Vatican unearthed an early Christian grave. This surprising discovery launched a secret quest that would last decades - a quest to discover the long-lost burial place of the apostle Peter. From earliest times, Christian tradition held that Peter was executed in Rome by Emperor Nero

and buried on Vatican Hill. But his tomb had been lost to history. Now, funded anonymously by a wealthy American, a small army of workers embarked on the dig of a lifetime. Come and adore Our Lord in the most beautiful Blessed Sacrament of the Altar. We have continuous Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament every Wednesday after the 12 Noon Mass until Friday morning before the 9am Mass. At least two people must be present with Our Lord at all times during Adoration.

HCA SCRIP Program

Holy Cross Academy has a program that provides a wonderful way to provide some financial support for Holy Cross Academy. Even if you do not have children who attend Holy Cross Academy, the SCRIP program provides financial support that goes directly to Holy Cross Academy for such costs as assistance for books, uniforms, and supplies, especially for families who need assistance

This is how it works. Most of us shop at various local vendors that

are supported through SCRIP. These include Giant, Weis, Wawa, Starbucks, Wal-Mart, Target and some very popular area restaurants such as Olive Garden, Red Lobster, IHOP and Outback. There is a complete list at the following website **shopwithscrip.com**

There are several ways you can order/purchase gift cards through the SCRIP program. One is to visit a SCRIP table after most Masses (including HCA). There is a volunteer who will provide you information and help you purchase gifts cards. Checks or cash are accepted. You can also go online and order gift cards for delivery to either HCA (after 10:30 Mass or during school hours when school is in session) or for pickup after Saturday or Sunday Masses at the Church. And for a way that is most convenient, set up a PayPal account and order gift cards on line for receipt through email. You will need St. Mary's enrollment code to set an account up at shopwithscrip.com but it easy to do. For the enrollment code or assistance, please contact the Scrip Coordinator at scripcoordinator@ holycrossweb.com or call 540-369-8354 (text okay as well). The Scrip Coordinator will walk you through the process and get you started.

Another advantage to using Scrip is you can prevent scammers from accessing your bank account. When you shop at Target, Walmart or at the gas pump, by using a scrip card instead of your bank card, scammers cannot gain access to your bank account information and thereby access your bank account. The funds are limited to the amount of the Scrip gift card only. Your bank account is safe.

Concerts at Saint Mary

On Friday, May 10 at 8pm, Concerts at Saint Mary will present the instrumental ensemble Washington's Camerata. Established in 2009, Washington's Camerata is a period instrument ensemble dedicated to the music of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. Founding flautists Kelly Kazik and Sarah McIver achieve innovative programming through the ensemble's unique instrumentation to bring charming and rarely heard music back to life.

In addition to performances throughout the Mid-Atlantic Region, Washington's Camerata is currently in residence at the historic St. George's Episcopal Church in Fredericksburg, Virginia, where the ensemble performs in conjunction with the popular chamber music series Beautiful Music in a Beautiful Space. From 2009 to 2012 Washington's Camerata had the unique privilege to serve as artists-in-residence for the Washington Parish at St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Oak Grove. Washington Parish was founded by the Washington, Monroe and Lee families.

The concert program, which will be presented by Washington's Camerata, will be taking the audience on a musical tour of eighteenth-century Europe! Admission to the concert is free and a free-will offering will be taken to support future Concerts at Saint Mary productions. Following the concert there will be a reception in the church's Parish Life Center where there will be an opportunity to meet the artists and share fellowship with others.
