Each participating church is asked to bring 3 dozen items (white socks, thermal underwear, boxer briefs and t-shirts...sizes L - XL for all). Please consider how you might be able to support this need — all donations are gratefully accepted at our Parish Office. Although it is a good thing that the temporary shelter is available during the harsh winter months, it highlights the continuing need for sustainable housing and support mechanisms in our community.
