

Infinite, Omnipotent, Omniscient, Eternal God subjected himself to the limits of our human nature. "You made him for a little while, lower than the angels; you crowned him with glory and honor, subjecting all things under his feet." (Heb. 2:7-8)

Prior to 2020, my best Christmas ever was 1991, six months after leaving grad school for a missionary order. I had no family to exchange gifts with, none of my favorite foods, and not a soul I had known for more than 12 hours. All I had was Jesus.

That Christmas stripped away everything from my celebration that was not Jesus and the Mass. So I asked Jesus for a Christmas gift: I asked Him to let me become a priest. Yep, best Christmas ever!

Since 2020 has forcibly removed so many of our comforts, expectations and ability to celebrate as we wish, may it be the year you remember that when you have Jesus, you have everything.
