

You cannot imagine the extreme joy that has animated us since we received the new.





Sacrament of Healing: Reconciliation or Penance

The Sacrament of Penance is one of the Church's two Sacraments of Healing. The other is the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Peanance is an experience of God's gift of boundless mercy that frees us from our sins and challenges us to be repentant and to have the same kind of compassion and forgiveness for those who sin against us.

"Sin is before all else an offense against God, a rupture of communion with him. At the same time it damages communion with the Church. For this reason conversion entails both God's forgiveness and reconciliation with the Church, which are expressed and accomplished liturgically by the sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation." CCC 1440

It is also a channel of particular graces which assist us in avoiding sin in the future, overcoming habits of sin, and growing in the life of virtue. Each of us can experience God's healing grace and love through this Sacrament!

Children at an early age (near the age of seven) should learn about and receive this precious gift. They are capable of understanding what is right, honest, kind and charitable; and what is not. The Sacrament of Penance is a positive instrument in developing a genuinely Christian moral sense. The experience can help us understand that when a child of God fails, or sins, it is not the end. God is waiting to help, to forgive, and to provide the strength needed to avoid sin.

Helpful Hints & Reminders

- Did you know that when you write a check, you should use only black or blue ink? All other colors may look very nice, but they don't show up on bank scanners and will not be accepted by the bank. So please use only black or blue ink when writing a check.
- When you receive your 2021 contribution statement, you may notice that one or more of the collections may show only a penny as your contribution. That's because when the envelope was received for posting in our database, no amount was written on the envelope, so a penny was entered to show that an envelope was received but the amount was unknown. Don't forget to write the amount of your contribution on the outside of your contribution envelope.
- From time to time, we receive contributions in envelopes from other parishes in the Diocese. If there is no notation, it is our policy to send these contributions to the parish indicated on the envelope. If your contribution is actually meant for St. Mary, please be sure to use St. Mary envelopes, or a plain envelope with your name and address indicated, or cross out the name of the parish on the envelope and clearly write St. Mary on the envelope so that we can process your contribution properly.
- Our parish supports the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in their outstanding ministry to those in need, through all Poor Box Donations. If you wish to make a poor box donation by check, please be sure to make the check payable to St. Mary Catholic Church. If you make your check payable to St. Vincent de Paul, the check should be mailed directly to them at PO Box 1493 College Station, Fredericksburg VA 22402.
