St Mary Building Committee Update

The St. Mary Building Committee exists to advise the Pastor and Parish Council on issues concerning long range strategic planning for St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Parish and Holy Cross Academy facilities and the design, construction, maintenance and updates to our facilities. The committee is primarily concerned with creation and execution of the Parish Plan by soliciting and utilizing parish input, working with outside consultants as needed, following diocesan building procedures and policies, and reporting progress to the parish on a timely basis. They are concerned with the details of planning, design and construction of each priority project.

In October of 2021, the Building Committee for the "Growing Our Legacy of Faith" project was formed. The committee is made up of parishioners who are successful professionals with years of experience in both private and government fields freely giving of their time and talents.

Status of our Most Active Projects on the Parish Plan

Re-Zoning of St. Mary's Campus Properties

In order to move our Adult Education classes from the Courtyard Room to the St. Joseph House, a critical step in freeing up space for the Adoration Chapel, we must obtain special-use permits from the City of Fredericksburg. We have met with the city twice to prepare our request for a special use permit for the property and there are several meetings to go before we are zoned. If you live in the city we would appreciate your attendance and support at the public hearing. We will let you know when and where it will be held.

Expansion of Holy Cross Academy

We have also worked with a design and construction firm on the expansion plans for the school. We have completed the initial design and have received preliminary cost estimates. The next step is to gain Diocesan approval to initiate a detailed design and vendor cost analysis and to begin the permitting process. This is anticipated to take nine months to a year, preparing us for a fall of 2024 ground-breaking.

St. Mary's to Walk for the Homeless

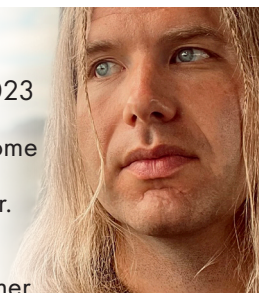

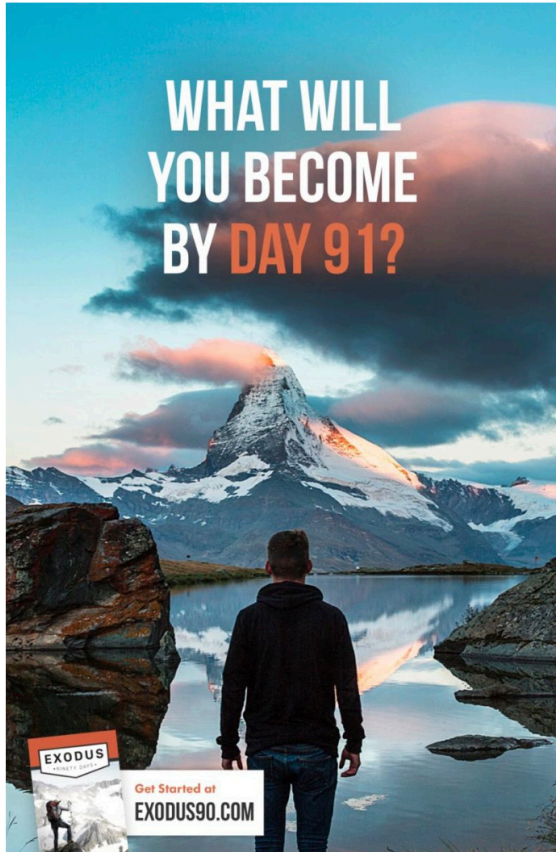


