



# **Cursillo Weekend**

Are You Looking to Grow Closer to Christ?

Are you looking for community? Have you recently experienced a change in your life i.e.; —returned to the Catholic faith, empty nester, convert to Catholicism, newly widowed, newly married, just moved into the area? Are you ready to get to know Jesus better? You are not alone on this journey. Many people find a small faith-sharing group is a nice way to begin to make friends, feel a part of a community, and learn more about Jesus.

Cursillo is a National Movement within the Catholic Church and is a ministry of the Arlington Catholic Diocese. The Cursillo method for small faith-sharing groups includes three major tenets – sharing with others about their close moments to Christ (piety), sharing what they are doing to enrich their faith (study) and sharing how they are serving as Christ's hands and feet in their environment (action).

This method is very successful in:

- · inviting people into a deeper practice of their faith,
- · bringing people closer to Christ,
- · building each other up in community make a friend, be a friend, and bring a friend to Christ,
- · leading people to deepen their spiritual lives through personal prayer,
- leading people into a deeper connection with and in service to their parish.

Cursillo is a four-day weekend retreat which is referred to as a short course in Christianity. Many of us might say, 'Well, I am a Christian, I went to Catholic School, RCIA, or Religious Education...why would I take a short course in Christianity?" The Lord loves us as we are; but loves us too much to let us stay where we are. Growth is good.

A beautiful part about Cursillo, is that once you attend the weekend, you are not left to journey alone, we have wonderful Cursillo groups here at St. Mary! Men and women who have attended a Cursillo weekend and continue to gather in prayer and fellowship. We welcome you to COME AND SEE!
