

#### SAINT MARY KEY PRIORITIES/PROJECTS

The Building Committee has been prayerfully and diligently working behind the scenes, designing, scheduling, and planning the improvements to our parish campus. These projects, made possible by your generous commitments during the capital campaign, are a testament to our shared faith and dedication to enhancing our spiritual community.

PROJECT	DESCRIPTION OF PROJECTS	STATUS
Sidewalks	Four sidewalks to be added to the Parish Campus to meet compliance standards, facilitating permanent occupancy of the St. Joseph House.	Three of the four sidewalks have been completed. The fourth sidewalk is underway.
St Nicholas House	The property is slated for comprehensive renovation, which will include the development of additional meeting spaces to support St. Mary Ministries.	The initial phase of the project, involving the transfer of existing contents to storage, is slated for completion within the next few weeks. We expect to begin construction in mid-August.
Courtyard Meeting Room	The courtyard meeting room will be renovated to create the Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel, facilitating prayer and the celebration of the Sacraments.	We are pleased to announce that a new altar design, conceived by Father Mosimann, has received the Bishop's approval. Renovation work on the courtyard meeting room is slated to begin in mid-August.
Sanctuary	Improvement to the Sanctuary will provide needed seating for the priest and altar servers.	Design has been approved. Given the church's busy schedule, we need to determine a specific date for this to be completed, with the aim of accomplishing it this fall.
Parish Life Center	Move the preschool out of the Parish Life Center and update the Kitchen.	The Pre-School is packed and boxes moved to HCA. The team has secured estimates for replacing the two ovens, cooktops, and dishwasher.
Rectory	Remodeling the Rectory to accommodate guests and Seminarians will provide a comfortable and welcoming place to stay.	A preliminary design has been created and is under review.

The priests were all smiles this week, especially after tasting the surprisingly good cookies! I hope you can join us!



We have a growing list of skilled and unskilled honeydo's around our properties (painting, yard work, carpentry, electrical, plumbing, etc). Will you share your talent and time?


#### Listeners

## Enrollment in the Brown Scapular – What is it?

Friday, August 8 at 6pm in the Church, Seminarian Tyler Burdett will give a brief presentation on the Brown Scapular, followed by Adoration at 7pm.

Friday, August 15 at the 6pm Mass of the Feast of the Assumption there will be Brown Scapular enrollment ceremony during Mass.

The brown scapular is a Roman Catholic sacramental and devotion, specifically to Our Lady of Mount Carmel, symbolizing a special relationship with Mary and a commitment to imitate her virtues. It signifies a desire for her protection and a dedication to following Christ.

#### Key aspects of the brown scapular:

#### **Symbol of Devotion:**

It's a visible sign of devotion to Mary Imitation of Mary:

It encourages the wearer to imitate Mary's virtues, such as humility and prayerfulness.

#### **Promise of Protection:**

It is associated with promises of Mary's protection and intercession, especially at the hour of death.

#### Not a Magical Object:

The brown scapular is not a talisman or amulet, but rather a reminder of the wearer's commitment to Christ and His teachings.

#### **Enrollment:**

A priest or authorized person enrolls the individual in the Brown Scapular Confraternity, marking their formal entry into this devotion.

#### Children's Charity - August

All Children's Charity donations for the month of August will be donated to Leashes of Valor, a national nonprofit working to provide a highly-trained service dog to every post-9/11 Veteran who needs one to ease the symptoms of Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) or Military Sexual Trauma (MST), an underlying trauma to PTSD. Their mission is as simple as it is critical: bring service dogs and post-9/11 Veterans together to enrich the lives of both. Leashes of Valor was founded in May 2017 by three United States Military Veterans with over 40 years of combined service and expertise in service dog policy and law, military canines and canine training, who know the healing power of canines because they experienced it themselves. The facility is located on a 10 acre farm in the Fredericksburg, Virginia area, with a live-in facility for training veteran and service dog teams. Training a service dog costs \$25,000.00 per dog, but thanks to the generosity of donors, veterans who receive a Leashes of Valor service dog pay nothing. 
