


- We met new staff: Amy MacKinnon, Assistant DRE and Sonia Spencer, RE Administrative Assistant







A new Catholic Burial Garden has been established in the Diocese of Arlington 30 minutes East of downtown Fredericksburg on Route 301 in Historyland Memorial Park and Arboretum in King George County.
