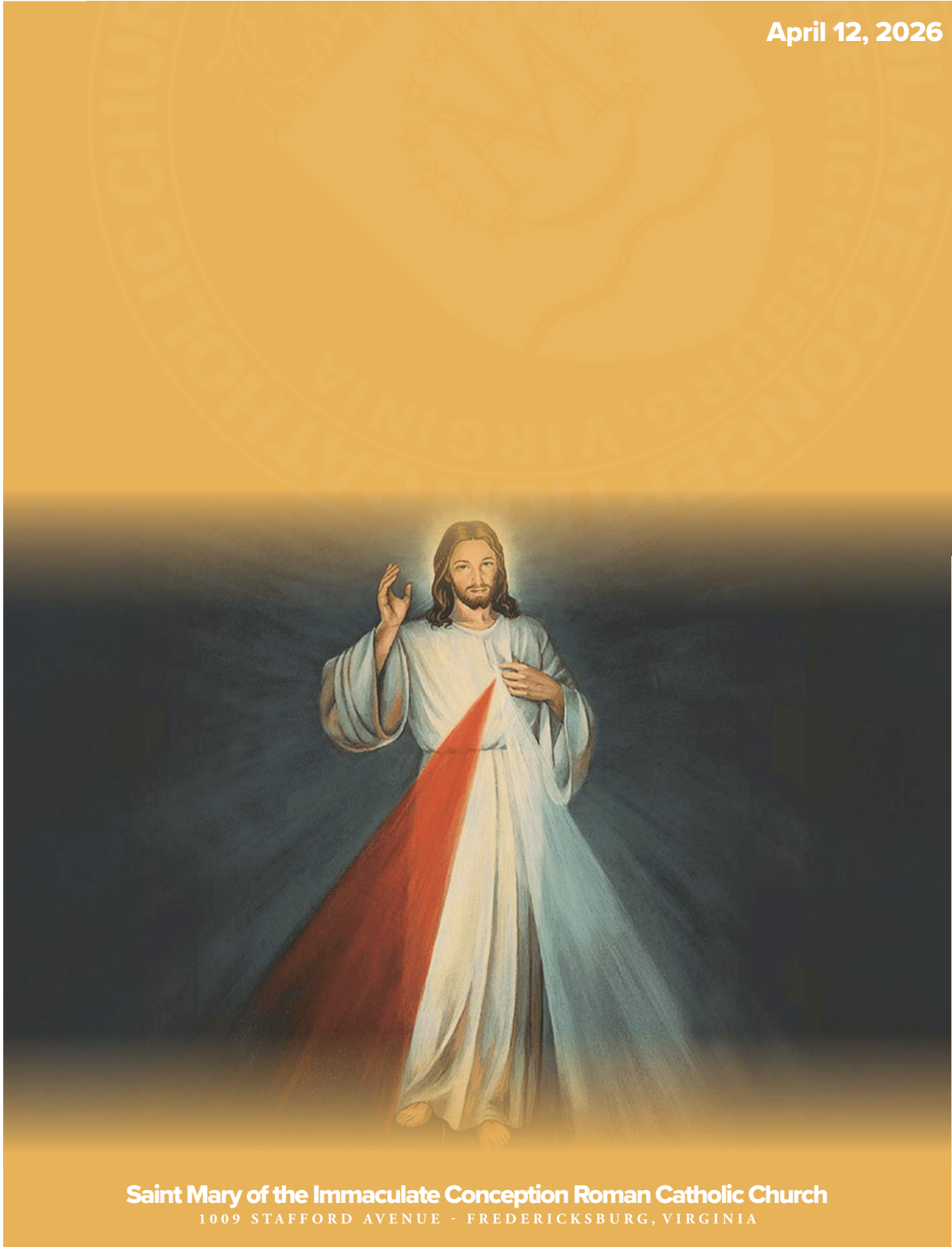

Jesus, I Trust in You!

The Divine Mercy message is simple. It is that God loves us - all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we can call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others.

The Great Mercy Pope

In his writings and homilies, St. John Paul II has described Divine Mercy as the answer to the world's problems and the message of the new millennium. He beatified and canonized Sr. Maria Faustina Kowalska. During St. Faustina's canonization in 2000, St. John Paul II stated that by providing the Church with this feast, he was fulfilling a "divine command" transmitted through the humble Polish nun. He did it in Rome and not in Poland to underscore that Divine Mercy is for the whole world. He did so to fulfill what she recorded as a direct request from Jesus in her diary: that the first Sunday after Easter be dedicated to God's Mercy as a "refuge and shelter for all souls."

After celebrating his last Mass, St. John Paul II passed away on April 2, 2005, in his private apartment in the Vatican. He departed this world on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday, shortly after the celebration of the Vigil Mass in his room. In his final hours, he was surrounded by his closest aides, including his longtime secretary, Archbishop Stanisław Dziwisz, and the Polish nuns who cared for him. During that final Mass, the Holy Father received the Viaticum (his final Holy Communion). His last words, whispered in Polish, were "Allow me to go to the house of the Father".

*"I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls... The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."
(Diary 699)*

Dear Folks,

Divine Mercy Sunday!

How big is God's mercy? Two years ago, on back-to-back days in Poland, we visited Auschwitz and the Divine Mercy Shrine. Riding the bus to the Shrine, we read in the Hallow app the daily reflection from Jeff Cavins about these exact two places. It was a chilling challenge to consider whether I truly believe that God's mercy is big enough extend to the commandant of Auschwitz. If you want to challenge and stretch your understanding of Divine Mercy, search on YouTube for the video: "3Ufy1ic88X0"

I recently had a conversation with a friend who was trying to understand whether something was a temptation or a grace. He was grieving on Easter over the many Communions received without sufficient spiritual and sacramental preparation. Was this a temptation to pride: "I am not like the rest"? Or was it a grace: "I am sharing in the Lord's own heartache at His desire to forgive sin, if only we would turn to Him?"

I think the answer is found in the response: transforming temptation into prayer with the Heart of Our Lord: "Father, forgive them, they know not what

they do!"

If something is a temptation, then the enemy of our souls will abandon that tactic if it consistently drives us into the merciful Heart of Our Lord. Don't worry—he will look for other weaknesses in your soul. But he won't keep hammering you with a temptation that habitually drives you closer to Jesus.

So do not despair at the sins of the world, or our country, or your family, or even yourself. When they come to mind, toss them into the ocean of mercy that flows from the pierced and resurrected side of Our Lord!

Ohhhh... and the very day I type this, I got word that the reredos for the Adoration chapel is finished, and shipping is being arranged! Soooooo close!

Inside Holy Cross Academy: Parent Highlight- Dobbins Family

We are the Dobbins family, and we moved to the area in February 2019. Our oldest, Mickie, began attending Holy Cross Academy in December 2020 during her first-grade year. Since then, Elijah and Rosie have joyfully joined the HCA family as well. We feel incredibly blessed to be part of both St. Mary Parish and the HCA community.

Our children have faced many challenges—both in the classroom and beyond—and time and again, the faculty and staff have gone above and beyond to support them. Whether it's providing extra instruction, offering a comforting hug, or giving emotional encouragement, HCA has always stepped in with compassion and care. One of the things we love most about HCA is that it truly feels like a family—everyone genuinely knows and cares about one another.

God is beautifully woven into daily life at HCA and is evident in countless ways throughout our children's days. During times of personal struggle, the faculty consistently points our children to Jesus, reminding them that no matter what they're going through, they are deeply loved and cared for by Him. Our children are shown tremendous grace in the classroom and are encouraged at every step—whether they are running ahead or crawling forward. Every bit of progress is celebrated, no matter how hard-earned.

Communication between faculty and parents has been phenomenal—far beyond anything we expected. We've even received weekend messages from teachers checking in when our children were sick or going through especially difficult moments. We are especially grateful for Mrs. Sanger and the incredible love she showed Ariyon and his group of friends, including our Elijah.

She joined them for playdates and trick-or-treating, and during times of sickness and loss, she was always present and available for our children. Our children's uncle—affectionately known as "Uncle Father Mike"—was a priest who passed away from cancer in 2020. The priests at HCA



often speak of him to our children, helping keep his memory alive. The kids especially cherish the relationships they have with the priests, who joke with them, listen to them, and genuinely care about their lives.

This year, Mickie had the opportunity to join both HCA Basketball and Soccer, and the impact has been incredible. Through these sports, she is learning so much more than just the game—values like teamwork, perseverance, and true sportsmanship are emphasized every step of the way. Coaches and teammates alike encourage one another, celebrate each other's successes, and lift each other up through challenges. What stands out most to us is how Christ is present even on the field and court. Our children are reminded that how they play—showing kindness, respect, humility, and integrity—matters just as much as the outcome of the game.

Athletics at HCA are not just about competition; they are an extension of their faith, teaching them to love like Jesus in every moment. Overall, HCA truly cares and consistently goes above and beyond for its students and families.

They are building saints, scholars, and leaders every single day—and we are so grateful to be part of this incredible community.

Mrs. Shira Howe's 5th grade RE students and their parents participated in a Last Supper-inspired meal that helped bring to life the deep connection between the Passover and the Eucharist. The experience focused on how Jesus, at the Last Supper, took the elements of the Passover meal and transformed them, revealing Himself as the true Passover Lamb. Just as the lamb once pointed to God's saving action for His people, so Christ on Good Friday gave Himself for our salvation, offering His Body and Blood for the life of the world.

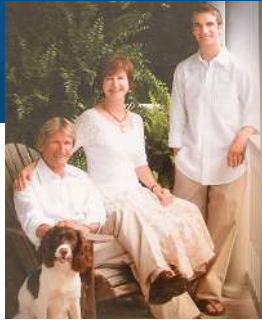
