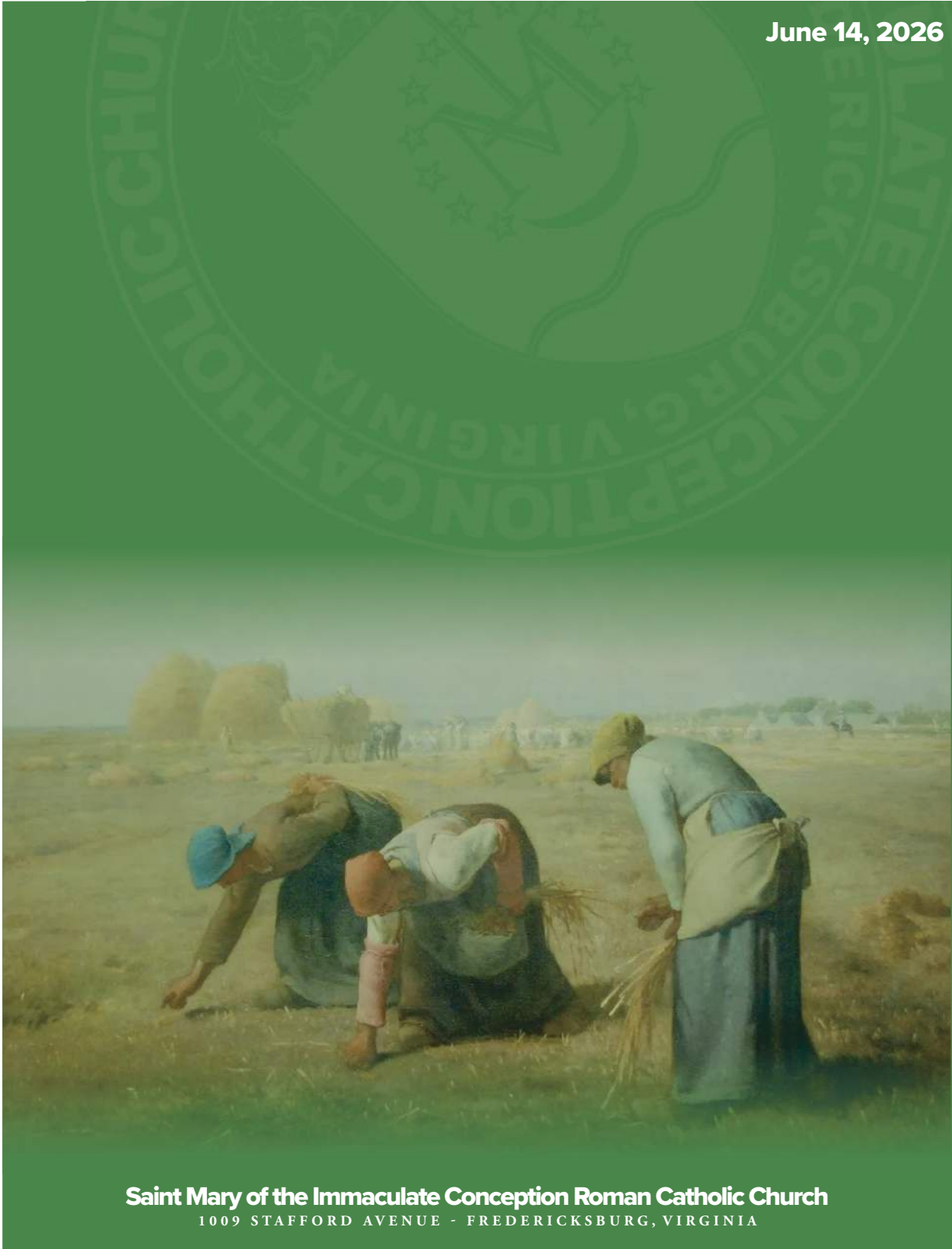

### **Divine Mercy Chapel Update**

We are excited to share a sneak peek into the second of four beautiful stained-glass windows depicting biblical scenes, designed to draw us deeper into the mystery of God's love and mercy.

### **Why the Story of Thomas?**

It is no coincidence that the story of "Doubting Thomas" (John 20:24–29) has a prominent home in a chapel dedicated to Divine Mercy. In the Gospel, Thomas lets his doubts get the best of him, demanding to see and touch the wounds of the Crucifixion before he will believe.

When Christ appears to him a week later, He does not meet Thomas with anger or condemnation. Instead, He offers pure mercy. Jesus invites Thomas to place his hand directly into His pierced side—the very place where blood and water gushed forth on the Cross as an endless fount of mercy for the world. In touching those wounds, Thomas's doubt vanishes, leaving him to cry out in total faith: "My Lord and my God!"

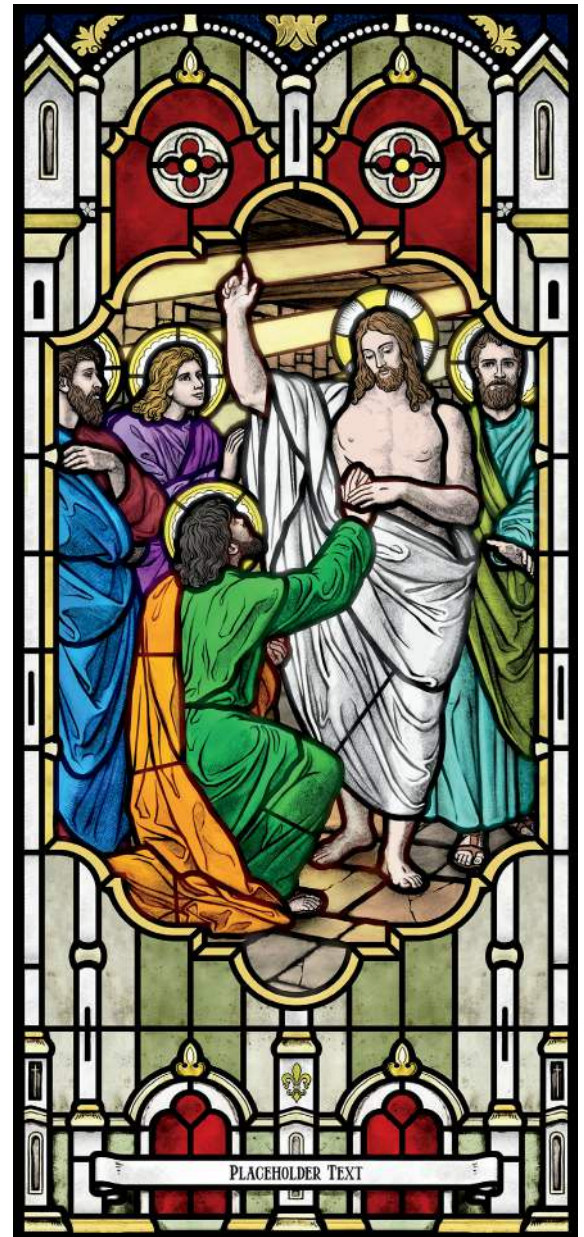
Where Thomas demanded to see, the Divine Mercy devotion invites us to take the next step: to gaze upon those same wounds and answer with complete reliance, "Jesus, I trust in You."

Divine Mercy Sunday and the Biblical story of Thomas share the same Liturgical Day.

### **Current Progress & Next Steps**

# from our pastor

Dear Folks,

This weekend we are joining the bishops of our country to consecrate our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus! Yesterday, many families came to the Saturday Morning Mass to receive blessings and prayers to enthrone the Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart in their homes!

And beginning this week, we will recite a prayer for our nation leading up to the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence! Semiquincentennial, that is one heck of a word! No wonder I typed 250th above!

So what is a consecration like this? It is a solemn act of entrustment by which persons place themselves, their lives, and their future more completely at the service of Christ through the maternal intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

John Paul II often used the language of "entrustment" asking Mary to intercede so that peoples and nations might open themselves more fully to Christ.

Take for example, Pope Saint John Paul II's motto, "Totus Tuus" ("Totally Yours") which came directly from St. Louis de Montfort's teaching on True Devotion to Our Lady. It is a motto that he strove to live and belong more perfectly to Christ by placing everything he was and did under the maternal care of Mary, who always leads souls to her Son.

We can never have too much entrusting ourselves to Our Lord and Our Lady.

## 8th Grade Final Days

The 8th graders at Holy Cross Academy spent the past week joyfully embracing every moment of what it means to graduate. 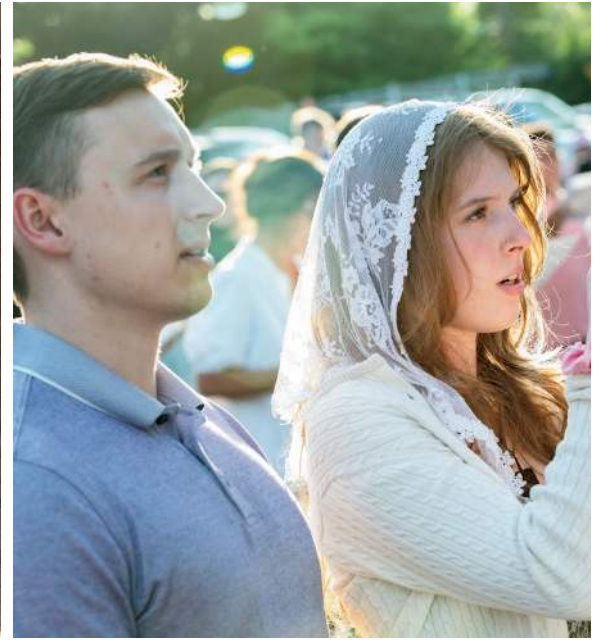

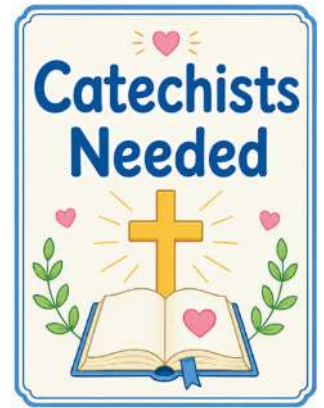

## Society of Saint Vincent de Paul - May

Did you know that the Poor Box located in the back of our church helps to fund the good work of our local Society of St. Vincent de Paul? The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul provides financial grants, prayers and emotional support every Thursday evening to folks right here in our community encountering emergency situations. Proceeds from the all-volunteer Thrift Store located at 142 Olde Greenwich Rd. Fredericksburg, along with private donations and the Poor Box make this assistance possible. May 2026 Poor Box contributions were \$1,877. Over the course of the month, 81 families (totaling 233 people) were interviewed, and the Society provided \$29,752 in financial assistance to these families.

## Men's Cursillo Retreat

The Men's 145th Cursillo Retreat Weekend for the Arlington Diocese will take place June 25–28, 2026 at the Missionhurst Retreat Center in Arlington, VA.

Cursillo (pronounced cur-SEE-yo) is a Lay Catholic movement centered on friendship, authentic Christian living, and growing together in Christ. It is about friends helping friends live and share the Gospel in a challenging world.


