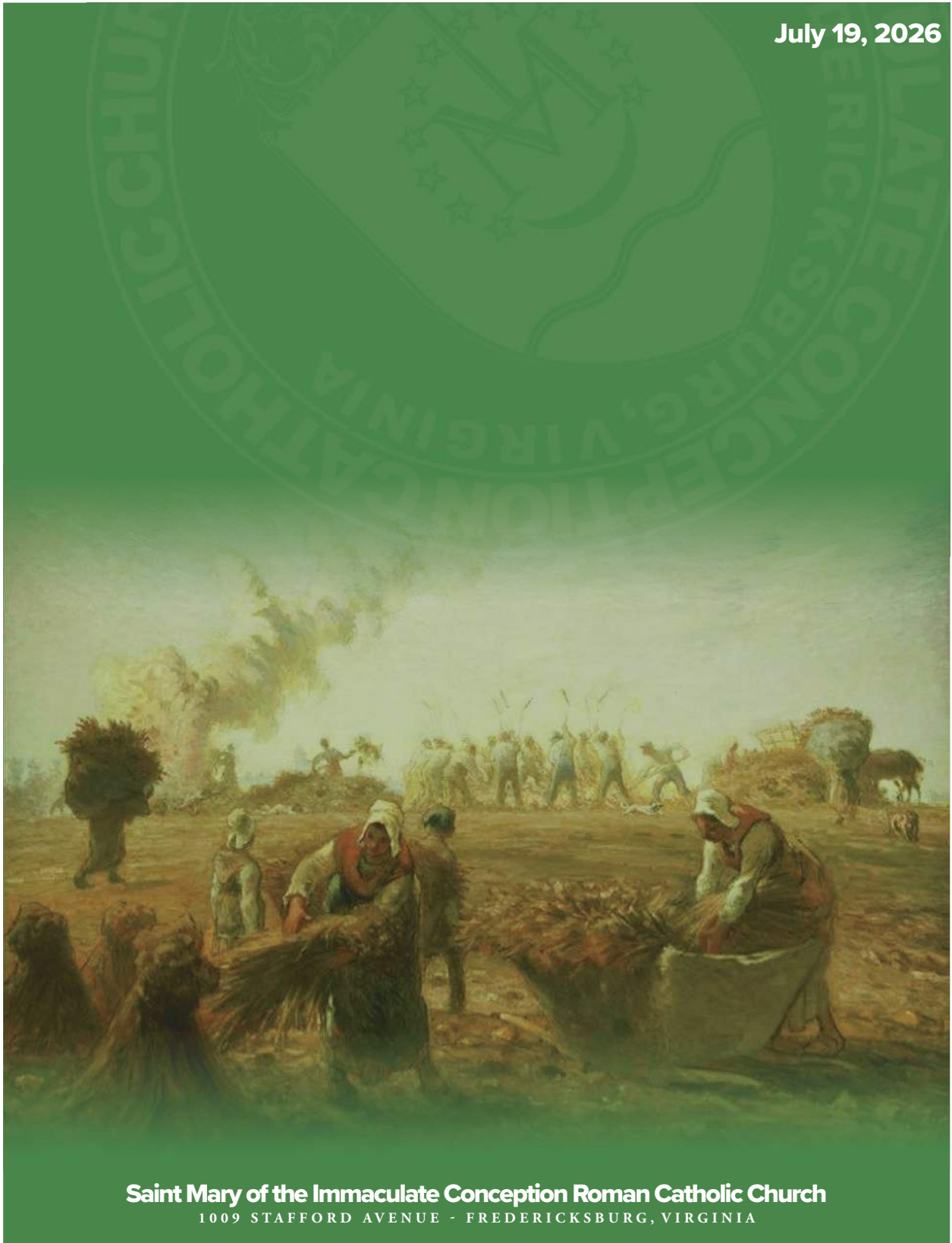

Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel Update

In partnership with Lynchburg Glass, we finalized designs for the four stained-glass scenes: The Woman Caught in Adultery, Doubting Thomas, The Crucifixion, and The Death of St. Joseph. These beautiful windows have been approved by the Bishop and are now in production. As you may have noticed, the Adoring Angel window was installed last week. Our focus has now shifted to the design for the windows dedicated to Saints.

Reflections on Divine Mercy and the Woman Caught in Adultery

This powerful window depicts the profound moment of encounter between human brokenness and Divine Mercy. Placed at the bottom of the window is the powerful scriptural inscription:

"NEITHER DO I CONDEMN YOU; GO, AND SIN NO MORE."

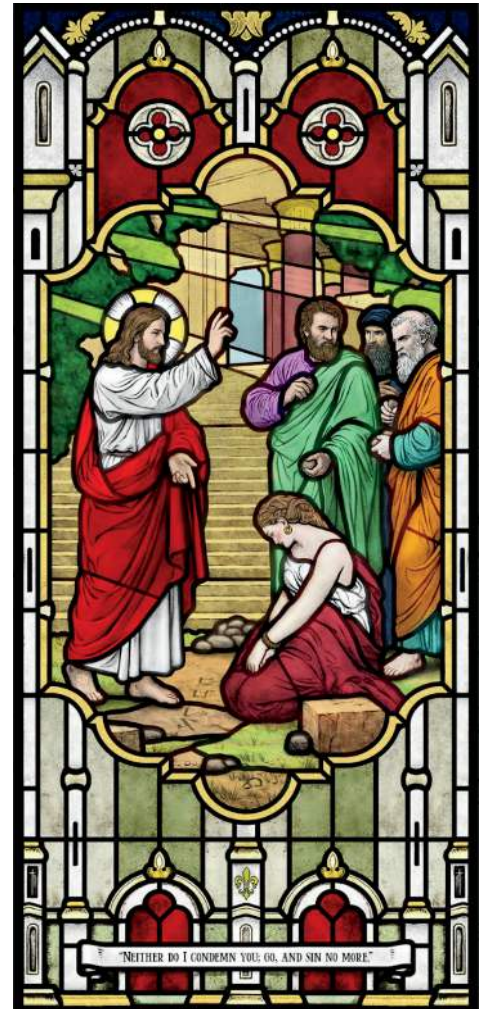
This scene is a beautiful illustration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the ocean of Divine Mercy. When the world was ready to stone her, Christ stood as her shield, offering not condemnation, but a path to restoration. He does not ignore her sin; rather, His mercy heals her so she can go and sin no more.

A Promise of Divine Mercy

As Our Lord famously revealed to St. Faustina:

"Let the greatest sinners place their trust in My mercy. They have the right before others to trust in the abyss of My mercy... I cannot punish even the greatest sinner if he makes an appeal to My compassion." (Diary of St. Faustina, 1146)

May this beautiful window stand for generations as a luminous reminder that no sin is greater than God's power to forgive, restore, and make all things new.



from our pastor

Dear Folks,

July, my favorite month! Ok... some big parties this month, by my estimation: the Fourth of July and Bastille Day! And one of the joys of having a summer birthday is that I was never in school on my birthday! I did, however, spend 15 hours installing hot water heaters on my birthday in 1986. I'll leave that story for another day!

Today, I want to encourage you, as life slows down a little, to habituate yourself to praying the Rosary.

One of my earliest associations with the Rosary is that our family would pray it together in the car whenever we went on a drive of more than an hour or two. Trip to Grandma's: three hours and a Rosary. Trip to the beach: four hours and a Rosary. Trip to Charleston: ten hours and a Rosary.

When I was very, very little, I remember pretending I was asleep so that I wouldn't have to pray. Oops... I hope it doesn't shock you to learn that I was a normal child who didn't always want to do the pious thing! I also remember being very anxious that I would mess up the Hail Mary, which was probably part of the reason for the pretending. But my parents were patient and gently firm, and they taught me to appreciate that our time together in the car included the Lord.

While I still often pray the Rosary in the car, I should point out that it ought not be the only time I pray the Rosary as an adult. Clearly, while driving, my attention isn't climbing the highest pinnacles of prayer. But teaching children the value of vocal prayer and

introducing them to meditation on the mysteries? That works wonderfully, because they aren't the ones driving and can put the time to good use!

Last October, St. Bartolo Longo was canonized. He is known as the "Herald of the Rosary." He built a beautiful shrine right next to the ruins of Pompeii, which I encourage you to visit if you are ever in Italy.

Bartolo's is a dramatic modern conversion story. He realized that his life of dissipation and idolatry was leading nowhere, and he turned back to God. He later wrote:

"As I pondered over my condition, I experienced a deep sense of despair and almost committed suicide. Then I heard an echo in my ear of the voice of Friar Alberto repeating the words of the Blessed Virgin Mary: 'If you seek salvation, propagate the Rosary. This is Mary's own promise.' These words illumined my soul. I went on my knees. 'If it is true... I will not leave this valley until I have propagated your Rosary.'"

Perhaps Our Lady is making the same invitation to us. Not necessarily to build a great shrine, but simply to pick up the Rosary, pray it faithfully, and let her lead us ever more deeply to her Son.

HOMESCHOOLING FAMILIES: Did You Know?

If you homeschool your child for all academic subjects and want to also homeschool him/her for Religious Education, you still need to register your child for Homeschooling RE and submit tri-annual reports. This enables the RE office to confirm your child's progress and sacramental readiness to the pastor, ensure that your child's diocesan-required paperwork is filed on time, and keep your family aware of all mandatory and optional events throughout the year.

HOME-TAUGHT OPTION

If you do NOT homeschool your children in all academic subjects but want to teach Religious Education at home, you need to register your children for "Home-Taught" RE. Following the same Christ Our Life curriculum as the children attending on-campus classes, you will submit reports upon completion of each unit in order for your child to receive attendance credit. Home-Taught RE students are expected to participate in all RE events and activities along with on-campus students.

Homeschooling RE and Home-Taught RE are only available for students who are following the diocesan sacramental schedule (First Communion prep in 1st & 2nd grade and Confirmation prep in 7th & 8th grade).

St. Michael's Lent Begins August 15

Did you know that many saints observed additional periods of prayer and fasting throughout the year beyond the Lenten season before Easter?

One of these traditions is St. Michael's Lent, a devotional practice closely associated with St. Francis of Assisi. Deeply devoted to St. Michael and the holy angels, St. Francis would retreat to Mount La Verna for forty days of prayer, fasting, and contemplation as he sought to imitate Christ and prepare himself for greater spiritual challenges.

Observed from the Feast of the Assumption (August 15) until Michaelmas (September 29), St. Michael's Lent is traditionally regarded as a forty-day period of prayer and penance, following the ancient custom of excluding Sundays from the count.

During St. Michael's Lent, consider:

- Deepening your prayer life, especially through the Prayer to St. Michael or the Chaplet of St. Michael
- Practicing acts of penance through fasting and abstinence
- Performing works of charity by serving those most in need in a concrete way
- Growing in devotion to St. Michael, our protector and defender against evil
- Receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation and participating in Holy Mass regularly

Welcome Fr. Gabriel Muteru of the Archdiocese of Nyeri on July 25-26

Our second collection will support the annual Mission Cooperative Plan Appeal for our diocese. Our parish mission organization is Archdiocese of Nyeri, Kenya. This appeal helps our brothers and sisters who do not have access to basic pastoral services that support and grow their faith, like Mass, the sacraments, religious education as well as basic needs – like food, shelter, and healthcare. Please go to arlingtonmissions.org/mission/archdiocese-of-nyeri-kenya/ to find out more about their ministry. Your gifts and prayers will be a blessing to families who benefit from this loving outreach in mission countries.

The Archdiocese of Nyeri has a lot of needs as it continues the work of evangelization that goes hand in hand with charitable works to serve the people who have both spiritual and material needs. Archbishop Anthony Muheria has focused on projects that are geared toward alleviation of poverty and the problems that are affecting our people in the areas of health, lack of education, and development.

Past Projects - In the past years the Archbishop has focused on among other projects, in building and maintaining a rehabilitation center for those who suffer from addictions (alcohol and drug). While this project is still work in progress there are other issues that require urgent attention.

Help for the Disabled - The Archdiocese of Nyeri is the home for Narumoru School for the Disabled. This home is in constant need of assistance. It attends mostly children but also adults who suffer from physical deformities. It provides corrective surgery and rehabilitation for the

patients as well as providing education and home for children with deformities.

Help for those with Autism - Another most urgent problem that has been always there but the Archbishop has made it a priority is that of children who are born with autism. This category of human beings is not well understood in Kenya and are left to the mercy of their mothers to feed them, educate them and take care of them throughout their lives. We single out the mothers because in many cases where a child is born with autism, fathers move out of their lives and they are taken care of by their mothers who become single mothers who also have other children to take care of.

In the territory of the Archdiocese of Nyeri there are no schools or facilities that cater for the children with autism. Some attend school with regular students but they often suffer from discrimination and bullying.

The Archbishop has been going to villages and organizing seminars to bring awareness to the villagers and society at large of the need to take special care for children with autism. He would like to start a school or facility that would specialize in caring for children with autism but he needs funds to accomplish this most worthy project. Funds raised from this appeal, for this project, will be used only for the children with autism.

Children's Charity - July

Children's Offertory Contributions for the month of July will be donated to Families of the Wounded Fund. This fund was created in 2005 to help the families of service members who came to McGuire Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Richmond with traumatic brain injuries and spinal-cord injuries from combat in Iraq and Afghanistan. Former Army Captain William Haneke, a wounded Vietnam Veteran, and some colleagues recognized the need to assist family members who were away from home tending to their loved ones when they saw two young mothers with babies arrive from across the country with no money and barely enough gas to make the trip. The organization gives 100 percent of all tax-deductible donations to the families to help with food, lodging, transportation, child care, diapers and long-distance calling cards during the many weeks a family is in the Central Virginia area while a veteran is being treated. 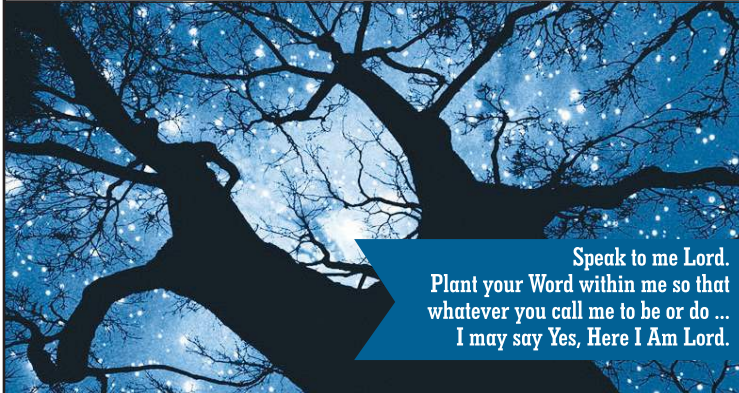
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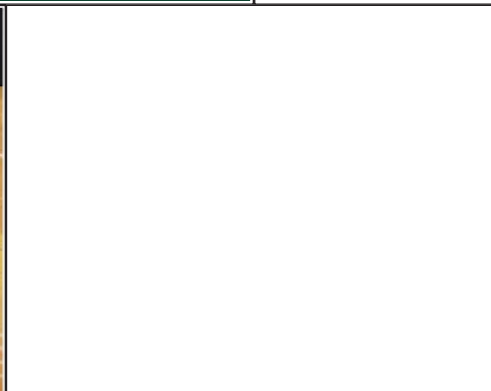
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
