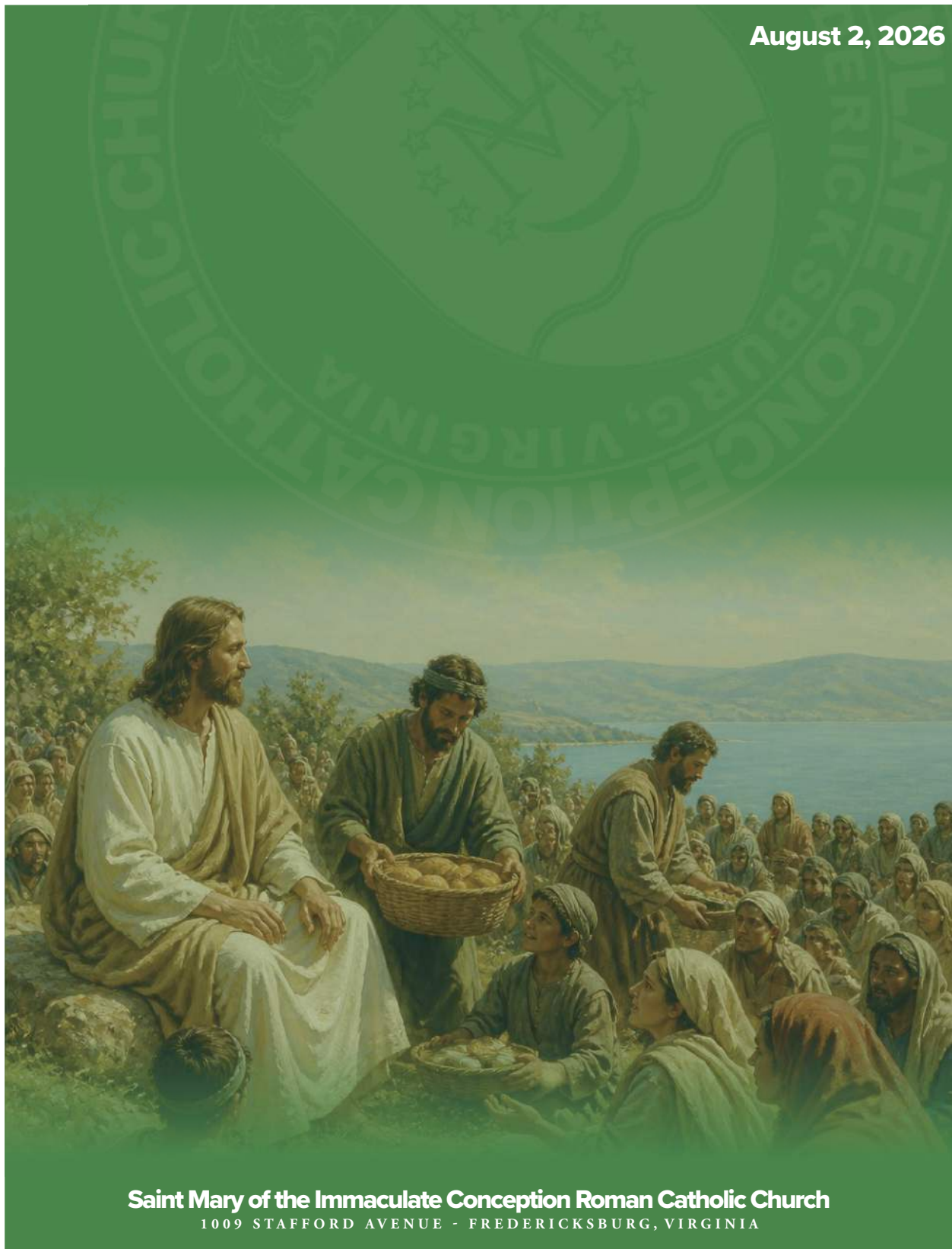

Meet the Artist: William O'Connor

"Not in the beauty of the color, nor of the brush is the greatness of this image, but in My grace."
— Our Lord to St. Faustina (Diary, 313)

Q: When you first heard about the new Divine Mercy Adoration Chapel and asked Father for permission to create the image, what was driving that request? What was on your heart?

"A culmination of several contributing factors led to my asking Father for the commission. Looking back, I believe the Lord had been preparing me in my work as a teacher and an artist to take on this responsibility, and I remember that, at the time, I had a desire to contribute to the parish's capital campaign in a way I believed was possible."

Q: How did you prepare yourself spiritually before putting the first brushstroke on the canvas?

"It was certainly a matter of much prayer. I had placed the entire idea of painting the Divine Mercy Image in Mary's hands, and during those months of prayer prior to receiving Father's permission, I asked Jesus for the commission, only if it were to be accompanied by the corresponding grace to complete the commission as he might like. Otherwise, I preferred not to have received it."

from our pastor

Dear Folks,

Comings and Goings.

First, I am very sorry to share that Deacon Alberto recently informed the parish and the bishop that he will be moving to San Antonio, Texas, to be closer to family. Deacon Alberto has been a very generous servant and collaborator in ministry both before and during my time at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception.

Deacon Alberto will be greatly missed by all of the priests, but especially by me! He still needs to sell his home here and find one in Texas, so we do not yet know when this will happen. You will be informed as soon as we can set a date for a proper farewell.

I have teased him that we will have a farewell tour like the great Cal Ripken!

Second, Deacon Leo Flynn has offered to serve at our parish. He had been serving at St. Patrick's, but our parish is closer to his home, and he requested permission from the bishop to serve here instead. He is retired, but we will gladly welcome the ministry he is able to offer!

"So... what exactly does a deacon do?"

The word deacon comes from the Greek word diakonos, meaning servant. While priests are ordained to act in the person of Christ the Head, deacons are ordained to sacramentally represent Christ the Servant. They are not "halfway to becoming priests," but rather have their own distinct vocation and ministry.

At the Second Vatican Council, the Church beautifully described the deacon as one who serves in the ministries of the Word, the Liturgy, and Charity.

A deacon serves the Word by proclaiming the Gospel, preaching, teaching, and helping to hand on the faith.

A deacon serves the Liturgy by assisting the bishop and priests at Mass, baptizing, witnessing marriages, bringing Holy Communion to the sick and dying, presiding at funeral rites, and leading the faithful in prayer.

A deacon serves in Charity by reminding all of us that love of God must overflow into love of neighbor. He is called to help the poor, the suffering, the forgotten, and all those in need—leading by example and encouraging others to do the same.

St. Mary's also has four men who have been accepted into the formation program for the permanent diaconate. Please keep them, and all of our deacons, in your prayers!

St. Michael's Lent – Begins August 15

Did you know that many saints observed additional periods of prayer and fasting throughout the year beyond the Lenten season before Easter?

One of these traditions is St. Michael's Lent, a devotional practice closely associated with St. Francis of Assisi. Deeply devoted to St. Michael and the holy angels, St. Francis would retreat to Mount La Verna for forty days of prayer, fasting, and contemplation as he sought to imitate Christ and prepare himself for greater spiritual challenges.

Rich in history and meaning, this Franciscan devotion dates back to the 13th century. Observed from the Feast of the Assumption (August 15) until Michaelmas (September 29), St. Michael's Lent is traditionally regarded as a forty-day period of prayer and penance, following the ancient custom of excluding Sundays from the count. Michaelmas is now celebrated in the Church as the Feast of Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, Archangels.

Today, this period is commonly known as St. Michael's Lent. Preserved and promoted by the Franciscans over the centuries, the devotion has inspired many of the faithful to honor St. Michael and seek his protection. During St. Michael's Lent in 1224, St. Francis received the extraordinary grace of the Stigmata—the Five Wounds of Christ—while praying on Mount La Verna.

Although not part of the Church's official liturgical calendar, St. Michael's Lent remains a beautiful opportunity to grow closer to Christ through prayer, penance, and devotion.

Pro Life Reflection

"Suddenly there were two men talking with Him – Moses and Elijah." Children's Charity for August

All Children's Charity donations for the month of August will be donated to Leashes of Valor, a national nonprofit working to provide a highly-trained service dog to every post-9/11 Veteran who needs one to ease the symptoms of Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) or Military Sexual Trauma (MST), an underlying trauma to PTSD. Their mission is as simple as it is critical: bring service dogs and post-9/11 Veterans together to enrich the lives of both. Leashes of Valor was founded in May 2017 by three United States Military Veterans with over 40 years of combined service and expertise in service dog policy and law, military canines and canine training, who know the healing power of canines because they experienced it themselves. The facility is located on a 10 acre farm in the Fredericksburg, Virginia

area, with a live-in facility for training veteran and service dog teams. Training a service dog costs \$25,000.00 per dog, but thanks to the generosity of donors, veterans who receive a Leashes of Valor service dog pay nothing. For more information, visit their website at leashesofvalor.org.

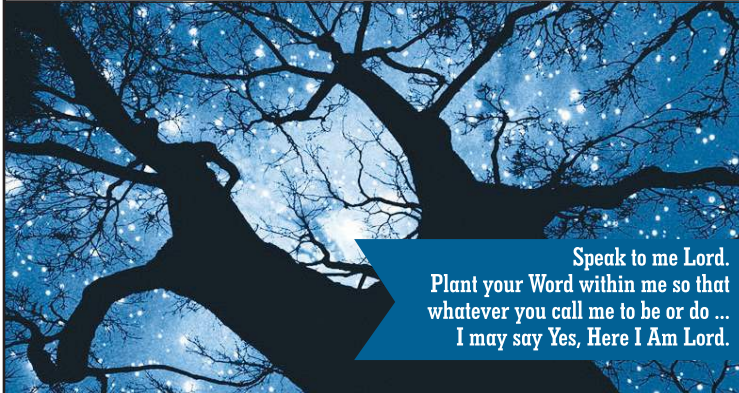

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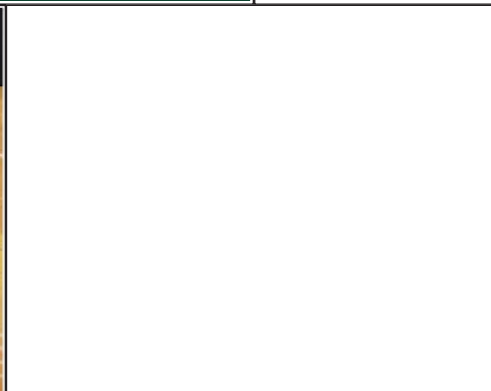
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
